

## **TREVILION**

As the most notable architectural shade structure at Evelyn's Park, the Trevilion offers a large, shady, seating space at the end of the Event Lawn. Part trellis, part pavilion, this structure provides flexible space for a large range of gatherings. Showcasing sleek painted metal structure, warm wood, and stainless steel metal cables, this architecturally engaging structure acts as a gateway into the park from Bellaire Boulevard.

Bench seats attached to metal cables allow park guests to sway as they sit under the fans creating comfortable, fun, and cool space. Movable seating provides flexible park furnishings to accommodate events, picnics, and resting areas.


# SPLASH 'N' PLAY

The Splash h' Play area is composed of an intricate paving pattern inspired by the elements of a flower. Comprised of jets and lights, this space is fun and engaging for kids and families alike.

Centrally located, this dynamic space can also serve as a plaza for events when the fountains are not in use.

Discovery Hills serves as the primary playscape for younger children. Complete with undulating topography to jump and play on, this play area includes grass climbing elements, a pre-cast fan slide, a tunnel, a majestic wooden interactive sculpture, and giant lily pad shade structures. Play spinners and a sand pit provide opportunities for parents to play with their children. Multiple seating areas can accommodate a variety of needs and provide space for the whole family. The play equipment in this area is accessible for children of all abilities.

Inspired by a riparian wetland edge, cool and earthy tones tie together play elements to provide an educational experience in a unique playground setting.

#### 4 FAN SLIDE

This Fan Slide is an artful addition to the younger children's play area. This sleek and durable slide is fun for smaller children and provides parents an opportunity to slide with their kids.




## **7** GRASS REEDS

The Grass Reeds form the Discovery Hills' "wetland" edge. Comprised of colorful metal columns and rope, they provide a balancing challenge for kids as they try to leap from reed to reed. Serving as a functional and fun play piece, the Grass Reeds also stand as an elegant art piece within the aquatic edge theme.

### **8** BARN SWALLOW

The Barn Swallow is a one-of-a kind play structure. Composed of hand-chiseled logs, this interactive sculpture is built from high quality rot-resistant wood that will stand the test of time to create an engaging playscape for years to come. In addition to a fun object to climb and play on, this majestic bird sparks imaginative play and serves as a beautiful art piece.

These cozy garden enclosures echo the architecture of the Park with beautiful and robust wood and metal detailing.


The Living Rooms are nestled in the Park's lush landscape offering name recognition at the entrance.







# SOLAR PAVILION

Perfect for parties, picnics, and events, the Solar Pavilion is a shady refuge with a modern yet warm architectural character. Supporting a total of 14,000 watts of solar panel power, this pavilion keeps Park visitors cool during the hot summer months in an environmentally sustainable fashion.

Water collected from the roof runs into a cistern which will be used in the Park's irrigation system

The Solar Pavilion fits within the architectural character of the site through the use of sleek metal and warm wood accents.

## **MOUNT BELLAIRE**

Mount Bellaire serves as the primary playscape for older children. Complete with an eleven foot mound to climb on, this play area includes steppers, a pre-cast concrete double slide, and a log jam play structure. A large shade structure keeps the slide cool as kids race their friends downhill.

Inspired by an upland meadowscape, earthy-toned natural play elements provide hours of endless play. Access to the top of the slide and mound is accessible to children of all abilities.

### **7** DOUBLE SLIDE

This Double Slide is made from glass fiber-reinforced precast concrete and is an artful addition to the older children's play area. In addition to being classically entertaining, this sleek slide is durable, elegant, and timeless. This slide is accessible via a path to the top if the hill.


## **THE VERANDA**

Overlooking the Meadow Garden and adjacent to the Splash h' Play area, The Veranda serves as a shady haven to the Park's most central and active spaces. Composed of sleek metal and warm wood accents, this structure frames the central views of the Park and provides a resting spot for guests.

With a prime view of the meadow, lawn, and splash pad, this addition will be one of the most photographed areas of the site.

# THE MEADOW GARDEN

The Meadow Garden contains a lawn suitable for small gatherings, play, and events. A diverse palette of meadow plants will attract birds and pollinators, as well as provide habitat for other species. This beautiful, naturalized setting promotes a wide variety of ecological functions.

In addition, the entire lawn is sunken to collect and drain large volumes of water in a sustainable way. Water drains through a cobble swale, purifying stormwater before it is returned to the soil. This diverse garden borders the Veranda where weddings and events can take place in a photogenic setting.

## **LUMINARIES**

A collection of Luminaries anchors the view from the promenade and honors major commitments to the establishment of the park.

Prominently displayed at the front of the park, these delicate metal pillars combine typography with straight lines of trunk-like columns, balancing sculpture and statement.

Appearing as a grove of trees, these recognition pieces illuminate the letters and landscape beyond.





At night, the pillars become illuminated beacons and create a playful destination within the Park.

## **BIRD DONOR WALL**

A work of art in its own right, the Bird Donor Wall stands at the entrance to the Discovery Hills and the Splash 'n' Play area inspiring children and adults alike.

The wall is a canvas for a colorful mosaic composed of metal panels with silhouettes of native birds. The colors of each panel are inspired by the Texas wetlands.


